4 Lessons of Multiplication
Even a little, in God's hands, can be a lot.

Order proceeds blessing.

Thank God for what you have.

Don't forget the scraps.

Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What's your favorite lunch after church? Do you eat out or go home?

Start thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- Is there a miracle in the Bible you struggle with believing is true? Which one(s)? Why?

Start sharing. Ask questions to get your group talking.

- Have you ever believed God for a miracle and He came through or maybe didn't? Either way, how did that shape your faith?
- Which definition of a "miracle" do you like the most and why?
- Why do you think God asks us to do something in the natural before He performs a miracle in the supernatural?
- What did you need to set in order before God can move in your life? Why do you think that's important to God?
- Why do you think it's easier to be thankful after the miracle instead of before?
- What practices do you have to remind yourself of God's faithfulness? Journaling? Scrapbooking? Mementos?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- *Take prayer requests.*

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- What's one step you can take this week to live out the message in your life?
