Key Ideas

4 Lessons from the Blind Beggar

Don't wait for perfect conditions

Work what you got

Don't worry about the crowd

Follow Jesus when times are good

Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

- What is the most beautiful thing in nature that you've seen with your own eyes?
- Did you get glasses or contacts as a child? How did that make you feel?

Start thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- Are you more of a doer, feeler, or thinker?

Start sharing. Ask questions to get your group talking.

- Jesus asked the blind man what he needed. Do you ever feel like God asks you questions He already knows the answers to? Why do you think that is? How does that make you feel?
- Sometimes we focus more on what we don't have and can't do rather than on what we do have and can do. Which one is easier for you and why?
- Do we ever grow out of peer pressure in life? In the story of the blind beggar, the crowd told him to be silent. What are some examples of negative peer pressure as adults? Can peer pressure be positive? How so?
- Why do you think we can be tempted to neglect our relationship with God in good times? Have you ever elevated God's blessings over God? Do you ever struggle to see Him as Santa over Savior?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

- *Father God, help us to act on your Word today, use what you've given us, push past the crowd and follow you at all times. In Jesus' Name, we pray, AMEN.*

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.

- What's one step you can take this week to live out the message in your life?
