Start talking. Find a conversation starter for your group.

Start thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

 What words come to mind when you hear the word "family"?

Start sharing. Ask questions to get your group talking.

- Are you more of an order or disorder person? Why do you say that?
- What's your love language? Physical touch, words of affirmation, quality time, acts of service, gifts?
- Why do you think we avoid confrontation even in a health manner? Why do you think as a whole, we classify the people who don't avoid it as different?
- Did your family have fun when you were a child? What are your most fun memories? What shared fun do you have with family and friends now?
- Do you find yourself seeing God in every moment or do you relegate him to only certain parts of your life? How can we be aware of Him in every moment of our lives?

Start praying. Be bold and pray with power.

• Father God, help us to have REAL families, that serve you with order, love, confrontation, fun, and God moments. In Jesus' Name we pray, AMEN.

Start doing. Commit to a step and live it out this week.
